

WHY TOURNAMENTS?

- Debate tournaments give students a platform to exchange ideas and think critically.
- Through argumentation, students build strong relationships and empathy for one another.
- Students learn to impovate, think creatively, and persevere as they are unaware of which side of the topic they will defend until the debate round begins.
- Students learn to listen for understanding instead of listening to disagree.
- Debate tournaments allow students to encounter subjects that don't appear in the traditional school curriculum.
- Debate tournaments allow students from all sides of the city to come together and learn from one another.
- Students build confidence in themselves and find their voice.
- Debate tournaments are a safe space for students who are exposed to high levels of violence and trauma.
- Debate tournaments are essential for a students growth in the activity and school performance.
